**AN ACT to Require Completion of a Hunter Safety Course as a Condition of
Obtaining a Hunting License.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2401-A, as enacted by PL 1965, c. 52, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

After January 1, 1978, a minor shall not be issued a license to hunt with a firearm unless he has satisfactorily completed a hunter safety course in firearms safety conducted by the National Rifle Association or an equivalent course designated by the commissioner.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires any minor issued a license for hunting with a firearm after January 1, 1978, to have satisfactorily completed a hunter safety course on firearms safety conducted by the National Rifle Association or an equivalent course designated by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.
