HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 490, L.D. 609, Bill, "AN ACT to Transfer the Eminent Domain Power of the Penobscot Indian Housing Authority to the Tribal Governor and Council and to Require Referendum Approval of any Action Relating to Eminent Domain."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§4736-A." by inserting underlined in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) after the word "property" the following:

'within the territorial boundaries of the reservation'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§4736-B." underlined by inserting in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) after the/word "property" the following:

'within the territorial boundaries of the reservation'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to ensure that the power of eminent domain of the Penobscot Tribal Governor and Council is limited to the land within the reservation area.
