SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 210, L.D. 620, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to the Distribution of Statutes and Session Laws."

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out in the 6th, 7th
and 8th lines (4th, 5th and 6th lines in LD) the following under-
lined words and punctuation: ", the office of each Justice and
Active Retired Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court, the office of
each Justice and Active Retired Justice of the Superior Court" and
inserting in their place the following: 'each Justice and ex-Justice
of the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts'

Further amend the bill in section 3 by striking out in the
11th, 12th and 13th lines (10th, 11th and 12th lines in L.D.) the
following underlined words and punctuation: ", the office of each
Justice and Active Retired Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court,
the office of each Justice and Active Retired Justice of the
Superior Court" and inserting in their place the following: 'each
Justice and ex-Justice of the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to avoid a conflict with an
existing statute, Title 1, section 503, which provides that copies
of statutes and of the Maine Reports that are furnished to Justices
and ex-Justices of the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts become
their personal property.
