COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 503, L.D. 622, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Gubernatorial Appointments to the Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy."

Amend the Bill by striking everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'<u>32 MRSA §2851, next to the last ¶</u>, as amended by PL 1975, c.575, §35, is further amended to read:

The Maine Pharmaceutical Association may, at its annual meeting each year, nominate 6 members-of-said-association registered pharmacists, whose names shall be forthwith certified by the president and secretary of said association to the Governor, and pharmacist members of said board, appointed during any year, shall be selected from the persons whose names are so certified for said year, unless in the opinion of the Governor said persons are manifestly unsuitable or incompetent.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to retain the current procedure for appointment to the Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy, except for the requirement that nominees be members of the Maine Pharmaceutical Association. Under this amendment, any registered pharmacist who is nominated by the Association shall be appointed. Peported by the Committee on State Government.
