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**AN ACT Concerning Gubernatorial Appointments to the Board of  
Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 2851, next to the last ¶, as amended by PL 1975, c. 575, § 35, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill removes the requirement that the Governor appoint the commissioners to the Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy from those names which are submitted to the Governor by the Maine Pharmaceutical Association. This will allow the Governor to seek recommendations from all members of the Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy, but will allow the Governor more discretion when taking appointments to the board.
