HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P.509,  
L.D. 628, Bill, "AN ACT to Equalize the Registration Fee on Dogs."

Amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out in the 6th  
line the underlined amount "\$5.50" and inserting in its place the  
following: '\$4.50'

Further amend the amendment in section 1, by striking out in  
the 7th line the underlined amount "\$3" and inserting in its  
place the following: '\$2'

Statement of Fact

This amendment would reduce the dog registration fee for  
productive males and females from \$5.50 to \$4.50. The registration  
fee for all unproductive dogs would be \$1.50. This amendment would  
also reduce the amount of money retained by the towns and municipal-  
ities for enforcement of the dog licensing and leash laws from  
\$150,000 to \$100,000. The amount received by the State would be  
unchanged or approximately \$200,000.
