viding transportation services, the present use of buildings, future needs, the adequacy of materials supplied to the staff, methods of insuring student competency, school district reorganization and any other matters that will provide the taxpayers with information on the efficient conduct of the public schools.

§ 504. Cooperative effort

The school committees or school directors of each school administrative unit shall share information and cooperate on the suggestions for solutions to insure the most efficient public school system possible. School administrative units shall begin the first study required by this chapter on July 1, 1978.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require, every 5th year, a review of the efficiency and effectiveness of providing public school education in each municipality or school administrative unit.
