COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" H.P. 516, L.D. 634, Bill, "AN ACT
Appropriating Funds to Maine Vocational Development Commission."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General
Fund to the Maine Vocational Development Commission the sum of
\$200,000 to establish a fund to implement the Maine Vocational
Development Fund. The breakdown shall be as follows:

	<u>1977-78</u>	<u>1978-79</u>
Maine Vocational Development Commission		
Unallocated	\$100,000	\$100,000

Any unexpended balances of the
commission shall be credited to a
special nonlapsing Maine Vocational
Development Commission Fund, and each
year thereafter the legislature shall
appropriate the necessary funds to
keep this fund at the same level, but
not to exceed what is recommended to carry
out the purposes of this Act for the fiscal
years 1978 and 1979.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish a fund to
implement the Maine Vocational Development Fund.
