Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the last sentence before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'A person, including a teacher, to whom such parent, foster parent, guardian or other responsible person has expressly delegated permission to so prevent or punish misconduct is similarly justified in using a reasonable degree of force.'
