
SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 517,
L.D. 635, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Corporal Punishment."

Amend the amendment in the last paragraph before the State-
ment of Fact by adding at the end the following underlined
sentence:

'However, if a parent, foster parent, guardian or other similar
person responsible for the long-term general care and welfare
of a person denies, in writing, permission for any teacher of
that person to use force against that person, this subsection
shall not justify the use of force against that person by a
teacher.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment states that if a parent or similar person
denies, in writing, permission for any teacher to use force
against that parent's child, a teacher shall not be justified
by the bill in using force against that child.
