AN ACT to Permit Hunting for Small Game on Sunday during Certain Months.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2454, as amended by PL 1975, c. 516, § 15, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§ 2454. **Hunting on Sunday**

It shall be unlawful to hunt wild birds or wild animals on Sunday, except that a person may hunt wild birds or wild animals except bear and deer on Sunday during any open season on such wild birds or animals in the months of December, January, February and March.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits the hunting of small game on Sunday during the months of December, January, February and March. Persons employed during the normal work week are severely restricted in their hunting by the present prohibition on Sunday hunting.
