HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 522, L.D. 640, Bill, "AN ACT
Concerning Arbitration for Municipal Fire Departments."

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement
of fact the following:

'As used in this subsection the term "public fire department"
shall only include fire departments composed entirely of full-time,
paid municipal employees and not those composed of a combination
of volunteer and full-time paid firemen.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment ensures that public fire departments covered
by this bill are municipal, nonvolunteer fire departments.
