HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 522, L.D. 640, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Arbitration for Municipal Fire
Departments."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "4-A." by
inserting at the end an underlined paragraph to read:
'This subsection shall remain in effect until January 2,
1980.'
