AN ACT Requiring the Marking and Removal of Ice Fishing Shacks on Frozen Tidal Waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA §§ 4102 and 4103 are enacted to read:

§ 4102. Marking ice fishing shacks

It is unlawful to place an ice fishing shack on the frozen tidal waters or to use the same unless the owner's name, address and telephone number is clearly marked on the outside with 2-inch letters.

§ 4103. Removal of ice fishing shacks

It is unlawful to fail to remove from the frozen tidal ice or allow an ice fishing shack to sink into the tidal waters.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to require the marking and removal of ice fishing shacks on frozen tidal waters.
