**AN ACT to Exempt the Literacy Volunteers of the Pine Tree State from the
Sales Tax.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 1760, sub-§ 37 is enacted to read:

37. Sales of goods and services to the Literacy Volunteers of the Pine Tree State. Sales of goods and services to the Literacy Volunteers of the Pine Tree State or to any subsidiary chapter of the Literacy Volunteers of the Pine Tree State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts from the sales tax, sales of goods and services to the Literacy Volunteers of the Pine Tree State and to any subsidiary of the Literacy Volunteers of Maine.
