AN ACT Concerning Fly Fishing in the Kennebec River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2553-A, as repealed by PL 1975, c. 772, § 17, is reenacted to read:

§ 2553-A. Fly fishing in Kennebec River

Kennebec River, downstream from Indian Pond dam in T1 R6, Somerset County to tidewater in Augusta, Kennebec County, shall be closed to all fishing except fly fishing for all fish from September 15th to October 31st of each year with a one-fish daily limit.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill reenacts Title 12, section 2553-A, "Fly fishing in Kennebec River," which restricts fishing in one part of the Kennebec River from September 15th to October 31st to fly fishing.
