STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Sealing of Displayed Copies of Adult Magazines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

17 MRSA § 2906 is enacted to read:

- § 2906. Magazines containing sexual matter to be sealed
- 1. Prohibition. No person shall display for retail sale any book, newspaper or magazine which deals explicitly and expressly with sexual matter unless that book, newspaper or magazine is sealed with a paper seal or plastic cover which prevents it from being opened until it has been purchased.
- 2. Civil penalty. Any person violating subsection I shall be subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$250.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that so-called "adult" magazines which are displayed for retail sale shall be sealed with a paper seal.
