IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Dogs Running at Large.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

7 MRSA § 3457, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 45, § 1, is amended to read:

§ 3457. Penalties

Instead of In addition to seizing and impounding the dog, the officer, having jurisdiction, may prosecute the owner of any dog running at large, and any person upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to authorize imposition of a fine in those situations when a dog running at large is impounded. Title 7, section 3455, makes it unlawful for the owner of a dog to permit the dog to run at large. The existing penalty, section 3457, would authorize a fine for this offense only when the dog has not been impounded.
