AN ACT Concerning the State Payment for Care of Abandoned Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

7 MRSA § 3406, as last amended by PL 1969, c. 242, is further amended by inserting after the 2nd sentence, the following new sentence to read:

The municipality of any licensed veterinarian, humane society or shelter keeping a dog under this section shall be entitled to receive from the State the sum of 50¢ per day for such period or part thereof as the veterinarian, humane society or shelter shall provide food and shelter.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that the State pay 50¢ per day to the municipality of any veterinarian, humane society or shelter which keeps a dog under Title 7, section 3406.
