SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 574, L.D. 698, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for 8-person Juries in Civil Cases."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT Concerning the Number of Jurors Serving on Civil Trial Juries.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'14 MRSA §1204, last ¶, as amended by PL 1975, c. 41, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit the court to increase the number of persons on juries in civil actions from 6 to 8 and to provide greater flexibility in the number of civil jurors, guaranteeing the right to 8 jurors if requested.
