HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 577, L.D. 701, Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to License Fees for the Regulation of Certain Amusements."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in the last 2 lines (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "reasonable fee as the municipal officers may establish" and inserting in their place the underlined words and figures 'fee as established by the municipal officers to be no more than \$20'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in the 4th line (3rd line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "officers" the following: 'to be no more than \$10'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish maximum fees which can be charged and to authorize municipal officers to set such fees.
