STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Pertaining to License Fees for the Regulation of Certain Amusements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 8 MRSA § 2, 1st sentence is amended to read:

Municipal officers of towns may license suitable persons to keep bowling alleys, shooting galleries, pool, bagatelle and billiard rooms therein, in any place where it will not disturb the peace and quiet of a family, for which the person licensed shall pay \$10 to such town such reasonable fee as the municipal officers may establish.

Sec. 2. 8 MRSA § 443, 1st sentence is amended to read :

The license required shall be obtained from said clerk upon the payment of an annual fee of \$5 as may be established by the municipal officers for each premise on which such machine or machines shall be located and shall expire on June 30th of each year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit municipal officers to establish fees commensurate with the cost of inspection, enforcement and regulation of the licensure provisions covering bowling alleys, pool rooms and pinball locations.
