COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 601, L.D. 726, Bill,
"AN ACT to Require Red Reflectors on Certain Long Logs Hauled at
Night."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'29 MRSA §1755, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 402, §2,
is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

In addition, ~~every~~ every vehicle carrying logs
during the hours when lights are required, which project more than
5 feet from the rear of the vehicle, shall display a red reflector
on the end of the log projecting furthest to the rear. Such
reflector shall be deemed inadequate unless of sufficient size,
properly located and maintained so as to reflect, at night on
an unlighted highway for at least 200 feet, the lawful undimmed
headlights of a vehicle approaching from the rear.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this / ^{amendment} is to require vehicles hauling logs
at night to be equipped with a red reflector at the end of the
longest log projecting from the rear of the vehicle.
