STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Increase Salaries of the York County Judge of Probate, Register of Probate and Register of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 30 MRSA § 2, 17th ¶, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 623, § 44-G is amended to read:

York County: County commissioners, \$2,893; clerk of courts, \$9,672; deputy clerk of courts, \$6,341; county treasurer, \$3,110; sheriff, \$10,768; register of deeds, \$8,974 \$11,500; judge of probate, \$8,375 \$12,500; register of probate, \$6,581 \$10,500.

Sec. 2. Effective date. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 30, section 3, this Act shall take effect January 1, 1978.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salaries of the York County officials, as follows:

Register of Probate	\$10,500
Register of Deeds	\$11,500
