COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 598, L.D. 739,  
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Regulation of the Blueberry  
Industry."

Amend the Bill in section 8 in that part designated  
"§4312-B." by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting  
in its place the following:

'2. Qualifications. Members of the commission shall  
have an interest in and general knowledge of the blueberry  
industry as a whole and shall be a processor, shipper or  
grower.'

The purpose of this amendment is to permit blueberry  
growers to be members of the Maine Blueberry Commission.
