COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 610, L.D. 747, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Right of Public and Private Residential
Care Facilities to Provide Special Education."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'20 MRSA §3125, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

5. Approval of programs. The commissioner may approve such programs for the usual public school year, or for a year-round basis, or for such other period as he determines appropriate.

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear that the commissioner is not committed to issuing such approval for the public school year only.
