AN ACT to Repeal Laws Regulating Floating Timber.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

38 MRSA c. 7 is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the statutes governing floating timber as they are no longer needed.
