Amend the Amendment by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following new paragraph:

behalf of an employer which represents or is an association

of employers or workers in the same

industry, business or profession as the prior to and business or profession in which the person was employed/while serving as a member of the House of Representatives or Senate of this State. The Secretary of State shall, upon request of a person subject to this section, designate that type of employer for which a person subject to this section may accept employment as a lobbyist.'
