SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 248, L.D. 756, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Solid Waste Disposal."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the  
and before the emergency clause  
enacting clause/and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 38 MRSa §1303, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1973,  
c. 387, is amended to read:

4. Municipality. "Municipality" means a city or town  
with a population in excess of 2,500.

Sec. 2. 38 MRSa §1303, sub-§§ 4-A and 10 are enacted  
to read:

4-A. Northern zone. "Northern zone" means the areas  
of Aroostook, ~~and~~ Piscataquis and ~~and~~ Penobscot Counties,  
the areas of Hancock and Washington Counties north of  
route 9 and the areas of Somerset, Franklin and Oxford  
Counties north of route 2.

10. Southern zone. "Southern zone" means the areas  
of the State not in the northern zone.

Sec. 3. 38 MRSa §1304, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1973,  
c. 387, is amended by adding after the first sentence the  
following new sentence:

The department shall establish separate regulations for  
the northern and southern zones for the time period November 1st  
through May 15th.

Sec. 4. 38 MRSA §1304, sub-§1, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 577, is further amended by adding after the 1st paragraph a new paragraph to read:


The Department of Environmental Protection shall evaluate all land disposal sites annually for potential environmental harm.

Sec. 5. 38 MRSA §1304, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 387, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

Preference on grants shall go to municipalities which costs relating to this Act exceed 3 mills.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment furthers the revisions of restrictions on solid waste disposal which are necessary for the reasons set forth in the emergency preamble.
