**AN ACT to Provide for Reduced Fishing License Fees for Nonresidents
paying more than \$150 in Property Taxes to a Municipality.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2401-B, sub-§ 3-A is enacted to read:

3-A. Special fishing license fee for nonresident taxpayers. Notwithstanding subsection 3, a nonresident who, at the time of application for a license, furnishes to the commissioner or his authorized agent, receipts from a municipality of this State indicating that the applicant, during the tax period next prior to the application for a license, paid \$150 or more in property taxes to any municipality of this State shall be issued a season fishing license upon payment of \$15.50.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to establish a reduced fee for season fishing licenses issued to nonresidents who pay \$150 or more in property taxes within the State.
