COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 627, L.D. 768, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Hunting and Fishing License Fees for Foreign Exchange Students."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §2401-B, sub-§19 is enacted to read:

19. Licenses to foreign exchange students. A resident license to hunt or fish shall be issued, at a fee equal to the resident license fee for a person of like age and status, to any citizen of a foreign nation under 21 years of age who is domiciled with a family within the State pursuant to any cultural or educational exchange program conducted by any government, educational, cultural or religious organization.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to specify the type of license to be issued to foreign exchange students, thus making it unnecessary for the department to create a special license for exchange students.
