AN ACT Permitting Sunday Operation of Bowling Alleys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

17 MRSA § 3206 is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the statutory section which prohibits operation of bowling alleys on Sunday until 2 p.m. and after 11 p.m. and which requires municipal approval for Sunday operation from 2 p.m. to 11 p.m. Similar recreations are not subject to this restriction, and this outmoded prohibition should be repealed.
