## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 640, L.D. 784, Bill, "AN ACT to REvise Fees which may be Charged by Towns for Licensing Innkeepers, Victualers or Tavernkeepers."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Such ordinance or bylaw may, for the purpose of fixing such fees, establish classifications of victualers according to the size, nature or other condition of business conducted and may prescribe for each of such classifications an appropriate fee which shall not in any case exceed the sum of \$250, excepting any town wherein a larger fee was permitted by law on July 20, 1939.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the distinction between certain size towns on the maximum fees and sets the maximum of \$250.
