AN ACT to Appropriate Funds for the Purchase of "Maine Communities and the War for Independence — A Guide for the Study of Local Maine History as Related to the American Revolution."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State Library; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services, State Library, the sum of \$395 for the fiscal year 1977-78 to be used to purchase 100 copies of "Maine Communities and the War for Independence — A Guide for the Study of Local Maine History as Related to the American Revolution" by Edwin A. Churchill. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funds for the purchase of "Maine Communities and the War for Independence — A Guide for the Study of Local Maine History as Related to the American Revolution" by Edwin A. Churchill. The Maine Legislature has consistently encouraged the publica-

tion of books dealing with the history of Maine as a means of preserving traditions of the State. This book was published by the Maine State Museum through its publications program. Proceeds of the publications program are used for publishing additional Maine-related materials for educational use. No state appropriations were used in the printing of this book.
