AN ACT to Require County Commissioners to Notify Municipal Legislative Bodies of County Budget Hearings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 53-A is enacted to read:

§ 53-A. County hearings

The county commissioners for each county shall notify the legislative body of each municipality within the county of the time and place of all county budget hearings within the county. The notice shall be given at least 3 business days before the hearing.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require the county commissioners to notify municipalities when a budget hearing is being held. The notice shall be given at least 3 business days before the hearing.
