HOUSE AMENDMENT/to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 650, L.D. 794, Bill, "AN ACT Requiring the Public Utilities Commission to Order a Community of Interest Study upon Petition by 10% of the Service Customers in a Telephone Exchange and to Promulgate Rules and Regulations Relating to the Establishment of Extended Area Service."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of that part designated "\$2605."

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to remove the provision prohibiting a community of interest study more than once every 3 years. Since some areas may be placed at an economic disadvantage by an existing exchange structure, a 3-year provision could create an undue hardship.
