HOUSE AMENDMENT/to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 650,
L.D. 794, Bill, "AN ACT Requiring the Public Utilities Commis-
sion to Order a Community of Interest Study upon Petition by
10% of the Service Customers in a Telephone Exchange and to
Promulgate Rules and Regulations Relating to the Establishment
of Extended Area Service."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of that part
designated "§2605."

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to remove the provision
prohibiting a community of interest study more than once every
3 years. Since some areas may be placed at an economic disadvant-
age by an existing exchange structure, a 3-year provision could
create an undue hardship.
