COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 654, L.D. 797, Bill,
"AN ACT to Terminate Administration of the Industrialized
Housing Law."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out at
the beginning of the first line (same in L.D.) the underlined
abbreviation and figure "Sec. 2."

Fiscal Note

Enactment of the bill reduces potential surplus at the
end of fiscal year 1978-79 by \$100,000.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to strike section 1 of
the bill which is covered by another bill (L.D. 1702, as amended).
