**AN ACT to Establish Procedures for Promulgation of Regulations
Governing Travel Expense Reimbursement.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 1541, sub-§ 13 is enacted to read:

13. Travel expense reimbursement. The State Controller, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may adopt, modify or abrogate rules and regulations for travel expense reimbursement and carrying out this chapter.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to establish procedures for promulgation of regulations governing travel expense reimbursement. Such regulations have previously been the subject of council orders.

This bill will have no impact on revenues or appropriations.
