STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Exempting Sales to Community Action Agencies From the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 1760, sub-§ 37 is enacted to read:

37. Community action agencies. Sales to community action agencies as designated in 42 U.S.C.A., § 2790.

FISCAL NOTE

There are 12 community action agencies in Maine which would be affected by this Act. If sales to all of these agencies are exempted from the sales tax, the loss of revenue to the State will be an estimated \$60,000 per year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exempt from the sales tax, sales to community action agencies.
