COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 664, L.D. 805, Bill, "AN ACT to Remove the Town of Carrabassett Valley from the Maine Forestry District."

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

The passage of this bill will result in a loss of tax revenue of approximately \$35,000 for 1977-78 and a loss of approximately \$40,000 for 1978-79. However, the net loss to the General Fund will be probably around 50% of these amounts, as Carrabassett Valley has been reimbursed up to 50% of its costs for fire protection other than what the Maine Forestry District provides.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add a fiscal note.
