'Further amend the Bill by striking out all of
section 2.'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting at the end
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sections to
read consecutively.'

of journeyman plumber from the law, thus leaving the law
as it exists today.
