AN ACT to Exempt all Wreckers from the Law Relating to Studded Tires.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 **MRSA** § 1375, 1st ¶, 1st sentence, as amended by PL 1975, c. 681, is further amended to read:

It shall be unlawful to operate a motor vehicle or combination of vehicles, except for fire department vehicles **and wreckers** and except for school buses during the months school is in regular session, with tires having any metal studs, wires or spikes protruding from the tire tread or any other metal protuberance from the tire tread upon any public highway during the period from the first day of May to the first day of October.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exempt wreckers from the law prohibiting the use of studded tires from May 1st to October 1st of each year.
