SENATE AMENDMENT" A " to H.P. 718, L.D. 840, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Augusta Sanitary District."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the first line of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. P&SL 1955, c. 139, §12 is amended to read:'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of that part designated "Sec. 13." of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2-A. P&SL 1955, c. 139, §13 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Sec. 13. Sanitary provisions and penalty for violation. Any person who violates this section or sections 14 and 15, or who shall place or discharge any offensive or injurious matter or material on or into the conduits, catch-basins or receptables of said district contrary to its regulations, or shall willfully injure any conduit, pipe, reservoir, flush tank, catch-basin, inlet, manhole, outlet, engine, pump or other property held, owned or used by said district for the purposes of this Act, shall be liable to pay twice the amount of the damages to said district, to be recovered in any proper action; and such person, on conviction of either of said acts of willful injury aforesaid, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.'
