SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 700, L.D. 842, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Displaced
Homemakers."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of section 3
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
General Fund to the Department of Manpower Affairs the sum
of \$15,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. Of such
sum, not less than the following amounts shall be used only
for the principal of loans made pursuant to Title 26, section
1606, subsection 3, paragraph D: For 1977-78, \$5,000.
Amounts for the principal of loans shall not lapse, except
as provided in Title 26, section 1606, subsection 3, paragraph
D. The breakdown shall be as follows:
