SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 719, L.D. 854, Bill, "AN ACT to Regulate the Placing by Nonutilities of Electric Utility Facilities within Public Ways."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the 3rd paragraph the following:

'Further amend the Bill by striking out in the 8th line (7th line in L.D.) the underlined words "public ways of" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'public ways maintained by'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting after the 4th paragraph the following:

'This section shall not apply to state and state-aid highways maintained by the State.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to assure that the placing of electric facilities by nonutilities, within highways maintained by the State, is accomplished in conformity with current established procedures.
