### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Change the Name of the Maine Boxing Commission to the Maine Athletic Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 8 MRSA § 101, 1st sentence, as amended by PL 1975, c. 115, § 1, is further amended to read:

The Maine State Boxing Athletic Commission, as heretofore established and hereafter in this chapter called the "commission," shall consist of 3 members who shall be appointed for terms of 3 years by the Commissioner of Business Regulation, with the advice and consent of the Governor.

Sec. 2. Amendatory clause. Wherever in the Revised Statutes or in the public laws, the term "Maine Boxing Commission" or "Maine State Boxing Commission" appears, it shall mean the "Maine Athletic Commission."

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to enable the commission to have a more realistic name.
