COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 683, L.D. 865,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Partnerships Between Husbands
and Wives."

Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out every-
thing after the amending clause and inserting in its place
the following:

'This section shall not be construed to mean that a wife
is not liable for the debts, contracted in the name of the
partnership, of a partnership between husband and herself
or between husband, herself and 3rd persons; nor shall it
be construed to prohibit or limit the formation of a
partnership between a husband and a wife or between a
husband, wife and 3rd persons.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is to permit 3rd persons in addition
to husband and wife to be included in a partnership.
