**AN ACT Concerning Grocery Store Coupons.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

10 MRSA c. 208-A is enacted to read:

**CHAPTER 208-A**

**ADVERTISING BY RETAIL OUTLETS**

§ 1271. Use of coupons

All retail grocery or pharmaceutical stores offering merchandise at reduced prices through the use of coupons or tickets to be presented by a customer at the store shall provide on the premises coupons to be given to customers requesting them.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Not all persons subscribe to newspapers, circulars or flyers when coupons entitling a customer to a lower rate on certain goods are available. These persons should be given an opportunity to obtain these coupons at the store.
