STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Establish Voting Lists Based on those Persons who Voted in the Previous Election.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 21 MRSA § 171, sub-§ 2, as amended by PL 1975, c. 761, § 11, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- 2. List current. The registrar shall keep a list current at all times by adding the names of new voters and by removing the names of those who have died, become disqualified to vote or failed to vote in the preceding presidential election.
- Sec. 2. 21 MRSA § 172, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 761, § 13, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would provide that the names of persons failing to vote in a presidential election would be automatically removed from the voting list. This procedure will provide a simple alternative to the present complex system for removal of names.
